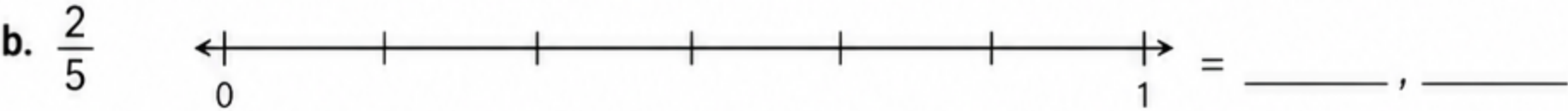
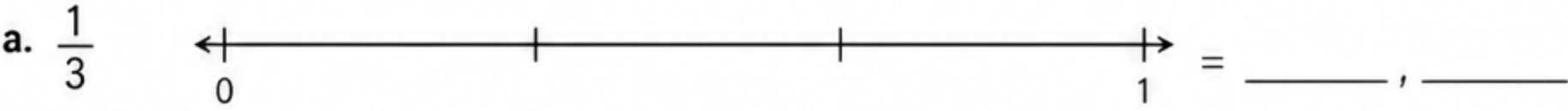
1. Write the fraction represented by each shaded model.
