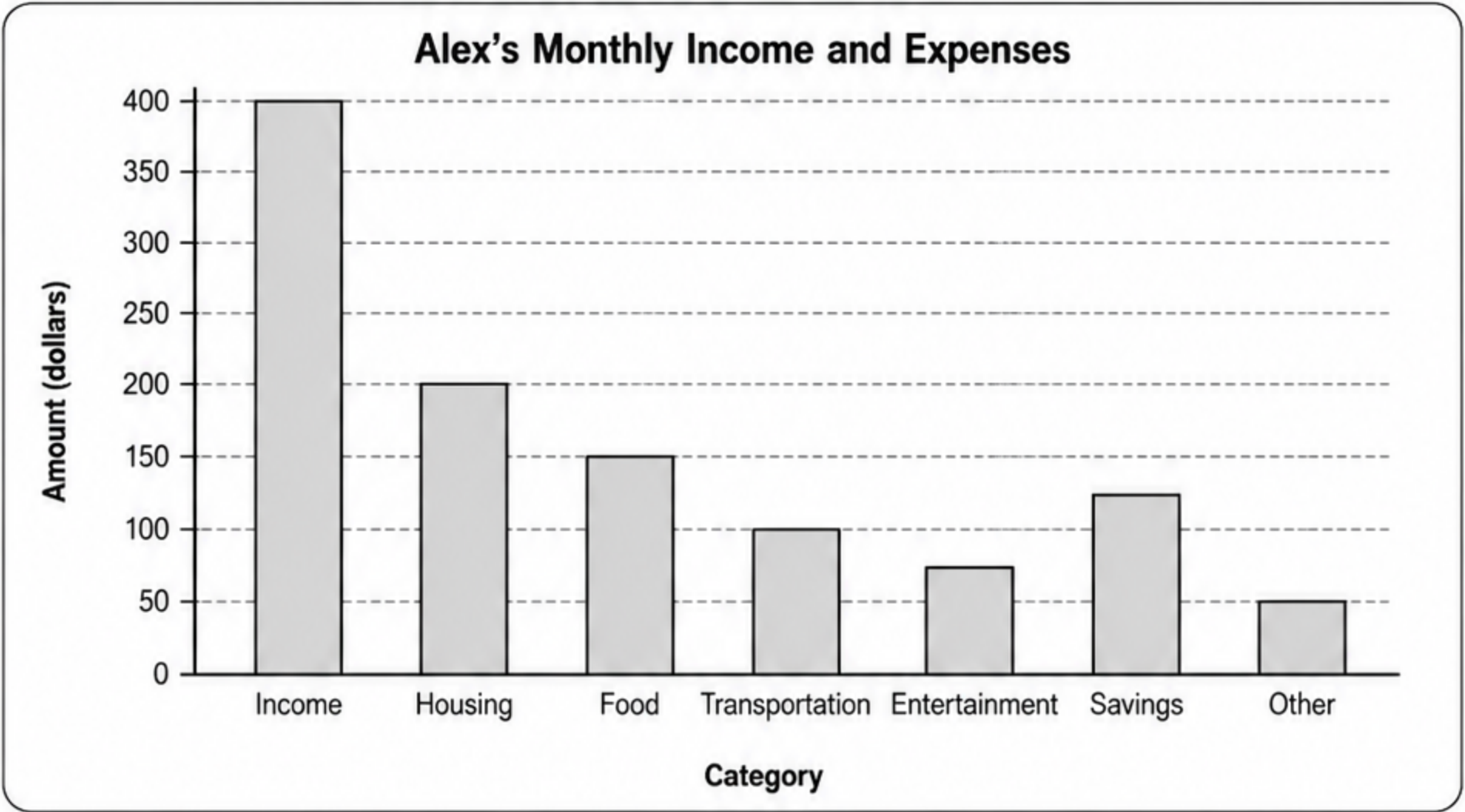


Reading and Interpreting Bar Graphs with Money
